## Liturgical Reflection

### New Roman Missal

In 2002 Rome issued the third edition of the **Roman Missal**, the official book of worship for the universal Church. The Catholic Church in the United States awaits the publication of the Roman Missal in the English language. Nonetheless, with the promulgation of *the General Instruction of the Roman Missal* in 2002, these liturgical directives became normative for worship in the Church. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal contains directives for the universal Church and contains particular adaptations for each country throughout the world.

## Liturgical Reflection

### Penance and Prayer

This Friday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>, all dioceses of the United States are observing a **Day of Penance** for the violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion, and of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. January 22<sup>nd</sup> is the anniversary of the Supreme Court decision, *Roe vs. Wade* (1973). Members of our Diocese are encouraged to participate at Mass this Friday, pray the rosary of the chaplet of Divine Mercy, fast and abstain, and join the Altoona-Johnstown Family in praying the following:



**Father, You have created us in your image and likeness. Strengthen our resolve to protect and foster the dignity of human life. The beauty and mystery of life is a most cherished gift. Watch over the unborn and guide the parents of these children in protecting their innocence. Through prayer and example, may humanity be hailed as the divine gift it truly is. We make this prayer with Mary, Mother of God, in the name of Christ the Lord. Amen.**

## Diocesan Groups Safe in Haiti after Earthquake

Two separate missionary groups from the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown were in Haiti when a devastating earthquake hit the nation on Tuesday. No one was seriously injured.

Father David Arseneault, Pastor of Most Holy Trinity Parish in Huntingdon, and three volunteers from the Diocese are in Port-au-Prince. Through e-mail communication, Father Arseneault said he suffered scrapes to his knee and elbow, but is otherwise unharmed. He is attending to the injured in Port-au-Prince, and he is asking residents to urge the Red Cross to send medical and disaster supplies as quickly as possible. Father Arseneault and his volunteers have been in Haiti for the past week and were scheduled to return home Wednesday.

A group of sisters – Sister Patti Rossi, CSJ, Associate Director of the Diocesan Missions Office; Sister Martha Burbulla, CCW; Sister Karen Grusek, CCW; Sister Jane Miller, CCW; Sister MaryAnn Palko, CCW; and Sister Marilyn Welch, CCW – is also in Haiti, along with several lay volunteers from the Diocese. The group was in the town of Hinche at the time of the earthquake. Through e-mails, the sisters said no one in their party was injured. The group has spent the past week-and-a-half in Haiti and was scheduled to return home on Saturday.

Not everyone is accounted for: a cousin of Rev. Fred Hickok of the 15<sup>th</sup> Street Methodist Church in Huntingdon flew into Haiti the day of the earthquake and hasn't been heard from.
