### New Roman Missal

The Roman Missal, the ritual text for the celebration of Mass, was promulgated by Pope Paul VI in 1970 as the definitive text of the reformed liturgy of the Second Vatican Council. The Latin text was translated into various languages for use around the world; the English edition was published in the United States in 1973. The Holy See issued a revised text in 1975. Pope John Paul II promulgated the third edition of the Roman Missal during the Jubilee Year 2000. The English speaking countries of the Catholic Church await the translation of the third edition of the Roman Missal.
