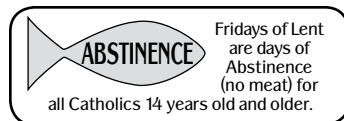

Liturgical Reflection: Revised Roman Missal

The promulgation of the third edition of the *Roman Missal* was an occasion for the Church to remind us to strike our breast at the words, “through my own fault” during the *I Confess*. Also, at the *Creed* make a profound bow at the words which commemorate the Incarnation, “by the power of the Holy spirit He was born of the Virgin Mary and became man.” We genuflect at these words on the feasts of Christmas and the Annunciation. An option was offered in the third edition of the *Roman Missal* regarding our posture for praying of the *Lord's Prayer*. if anyone wishes he or she may pray the *Our Father* in the *Orans* posture – holding both hands with palms outward. At the end of the *Lord's Prayer*, only the priest presiding at Mass keeps his hands outstretched for the “Deliver us, Lord, from every evil...”

Self Examination

We are in the midst of the **Scrutinies**. Last week we talked about the *Conversion of Self* (the woman at the well, JOHN 4:5-42); this week, the Second Scrutiny, we concentrate on the *Repentance of Heart* (the man born blind, JOHN 9:1-41); next Sunday we look into the *Spiritual Purpose of Action* (the death of Lazarus, JOHN 11:1-45). The Elect and **all** the Faithful are encouraged to scrutinize our lives in light of the Christian call to discipleship to follow the crucified and risen Christ.

Help for Japan

This weekend, as part of our biblical duty of almsgiving, we have the annual collection for the work of Catholic Relief Services (“**Jesus in Disguise**”). This year the collection will be directed to the relief of victims of the earthquake and tsunami on March 11th. As you've learned from the news, the devastation and suffering are immense; please keep in mind, as part of your Lenten sacrifice, the needs of the victims in Japan and elsewhere.
