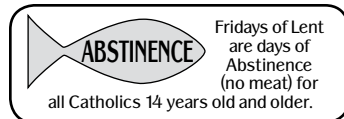

Liturgical Reflection: Revised Roman Missal

The Church directed that the vessels be purified following the reception of Holy Communion. The vessels are to be purified by the priest or deacon or instituted acolyte. All remaining consecrated elements are brought back to the altar following Communion. There the consecrated Bread is placed in the ciborium to be taken to the tabernacle. The particles from the remaining ciboria are gathered into the celebrant's chalice. Also, at the altar, all remaining Precious Blood is consumed by any minister. The chalices and ciboria are taken to the credence table where water is poured into the chalices. The proper minister then drinks from the celebrant's chalice consuming the remaining particles of the Body of Christ. Following Mass, the vessels having been purified, are ready to be washed by the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

Self Examination

We conclude our examination of the **Scrutinies of Action** (the death of Lazarus, JOHN 11:1-45). The Elect and **all** the Faithful are encouraged to scrutinize our lives in light of the Christian call to discipleship to follow the crucified and risen Christ.

Easter Blessings

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday. If the weather cooperates, we may have an outdoor procession. Holy Week follows with Mass at seven o'clock on Holy Thursday evening to begin the Pascal Triduum. On Good Friday, the Rosary will be prayed at 9:30 in the morning, with the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 2:30 and liturgy at 3:00 that afternoon (remember that Good Friday is a day of abstinence **and** fasting). On Holy Saturday we continue the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 11:30 AM and blessing of food at noon. At the Easter Vigil at 8:30 PM, our Catechumens and Candidates will be officially received into the Church. Father White will bless the children's Easter baskets at Easter Sunday Mass.

Annual Catholic Appeal
