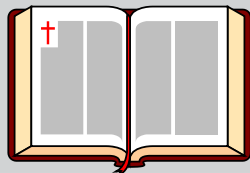

Liturgical Reflection: The Revised Roman Missal

The revised *Roman Missal* will become the official book of worship in the United States on November 27, 2011. All English speaking countries will then implement the newly translated prayers and dialogues contained in the third edition of the missal. The Mass itself remains the same; the translation of the original Latin into English will be different. New sounds will accompany the centuries of truth and tradition. The English translation reflects more closely the Latin translation into the other languages of the world.
