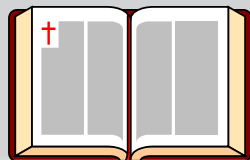

### Liturgical Reflection:

### The Revised Roman Missal

English is firmly grounded in the formal worship of the Church. Since the Second Vatican Council, Catholics have become accustomed to praying in the vernacular. The newly revised *Roman Missal* claims the English language as the vehicle for expressing the mystery of the faith. Some of the changes will seem rather small, while others will be considerably larger. For example, the *Lamb of God* will not change at all, however, the *Glory to God* and the *Creed* will see significant changes in translation. The guiding principle was to achieve a translation that better evokes what the Latin says.
