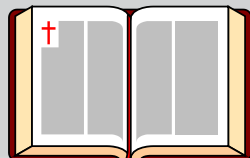

Liturgical Reflection:

The Revised Roman Missal

The revised translation of the *Roman Missal* will not affect the scripture readings, the General Intercessions, or your favorite hymns. The new translation pertains to the words we speak or sing at Mass, and to the prayers that the priest prays alone during Mass. The words in the *Roman Missal* first appear in Latin. From Rome the texts are sent out to all corners of the world. Each country then translates the Latin edition into the native tongue of the Catholic people. English speaking Catholics await a new revision and translation of these Latin texts.

Diocesan Feast Day

This Friday, **May 27th**, is a feast in the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown. We celebrate the feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary under the title of Mary, Mother of the Church.
