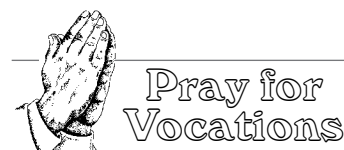

Liturgical Reflection: The Ascension

This Thursday, June 2nd, is a **Holy Day of Obligation** in the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown. The Church will celebrate the solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. Forty days have passed since the great Easter feast. Jesus Christ, risen and ascended, sits at the right hand of God, until He comes in all his glory. We, the baptized, are to give witness to this truth by the way we live our lives. Catholics are to participate at Mass on this day. Masses here at Immaculate Conception will be at 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM.

The Revised Roman Missal

All the musical compositions that accompany the revised **Roman Missal** will be revised to reflect the new translation. The *Glory to God*, the *Creed*, the *Holy, Holy*, the three *Memorial Acclamations*, and the *Doxology* will all have new music to compliment the new words. Composers have been busy at work bringing the new translations to familiar Mass settings. And new Mass settings are being composed to celebrate the noteworthy event of the newly revised **Roman Missal**. Choirs and cantors will be busy preparing so the Faithful gathered at Mass will quickly and smoothly become familiar with both the words and music.
