Graduation / VBS

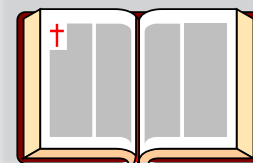

Liturgical Reflection:

Roman Missal

The revised *Roman Missal* maintains the formal parts of the Mass as prayed for almost the last half century. The missal will contain the official four parts of the Liturgy: the Introductory Rites; the Liturgy of the Word; the Liturgy of the Eucharist with the Communion Rite; and the Concluding Rite. How the Mass is prayed is not changing. The words that accompany our actions at Mass will be changing. This is a rich opportunity for Catholics to review and understand the parts of the Mass. A keener understanding will directly affect our participation and love of the Church's worship.
