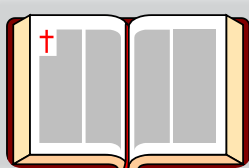

Liturgical Reflection:

Revised Missal

When the newly revised *Roman Missal* takes effect on the First Sunday of Advent in November of 2011, the invocation of the Trinity with the sign of the cross at the beginning of Mass will not change. Also, as Mass concludes when the presider gives a blessing, neither will the Trinitarian formula change. It is the Catholic custom to begin and end prayer in the name of God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. As we invoke the name of God, we sign ourselves with the sign of the cross.

Repairs

Ever since our church was built, we've had roof problems. Unfortunately, it's time to repair again. The original roof was guaranteed, but the roofer went out of business; this time the Finance Council has chosen a much larger company who will give a twenty-year guarantee and will make semi-annual inspections to forestall any possible problems. The total cost will be just under \$25,000 (any higher and we would have to get diocesan approval). It's also time to re-seal and line the parking lot, but we may be able to get help from the prison trustees who recently helped beautify our church grounds.
