#### The Lord's Day

The primary way in which we celebrate the Lord's Day is with our participation in the Sunday Eucharist. What better way to celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord than by celebration of the memorial of his Passion, Death, and Resurrection? This prayer is not a solitary, private event. Instead, we come together as the people of God, the Church, to worship with one heart and one voice. No member of the faithful should be absent from the Sunday Eucharist without a serious reason. And we keep Sunday all day. In addition to attending Mass each Sunday, we should refrain from those activities which impede the worship of God and disturb the joy proper to the day the Lord or the necessary relaxation of mind and body.
