Special Outdoor Mass

Liturgical Reflection on the Revised Missal:

Liturgy and Life

Receiving the Eucharistic Liturgy and Holy Communion should strengthen us to conform our lives more closely to the example of Christ. As Jesus knelt before his Apostles to wash their feet (John 13), giving them an example of humble service, so must we who bear the name Christian live our lives in service to our brothers and sisters. We are sent forth from Mass to love and serve the Lord in our concern of love for others. To help in this endeavor, Church Tradition has identified works of mercy. Eucharistic people live the corporal works of mercy: feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and imprisoned, giving drink to the thirsty, and burying the dead. The spiritual works of mercy include: converting sinners, instructing the ignorant, advising the doubtful, comforting the sorrowful, bearing wrongs patiently, forgiving injuries, and praying for the living and dead.

Memorials and Feasts

FRIDAY Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major in Rome. Formerly called Our Lady of the Snows, this is one of Rome's most prestigious churches, sitting on the horizon of the seven hills that form Rome, along with three other papal basilicas: Saint John Lateran, Saint Peter, and Saint Paul Outside the Walls. Among its most prized possessions are relics of the manger in Bethlehem.

SATURDAY Transfiguration of the Lord. The readings and prayers for this day emphasize that the glory of Christ on Mount Tabor was not a unique event but instead offers a glimpse of the glory in which the Church will one day share. In Christ's Transfiguration we see "a body like our own" shining with glory, and recognize that we are called to share that glory, if we will but listen to Christ's word and receive Eucharist.
