## Liturgical Reflection on the Revised Missal:

### The Lord's Day

Each Sunday is a "little Easter." The day of the Lord is the remembrance of the Lord's rising from the dead. The primary way in which we celebrate the Lord's Day is with our participation in the Sunday Eucharist. After Mass, consider the following to celebrate the Lord's Day more fully. Share a family meal. Go for a walk or bike ride and give thanks to God for the beauty of nature. Read the Bible or a spiritual book. Pray the rosary or the chaplet of Divine Mercy or the Liturgy of the Hours. Visit the homebound. Visit the cemetery and pray at the grave of a loved one. Try not to use Sunday as a catch-all day for errands and household chores.
