Liturgical Reflection on the Revised Missal:

Pray with Body, Mind, & Voice

In the celebration of the Mass we raise our hearts and minds to God. We are creatures of body as well as spirit, so our prayer is not confined to our minds and hearts. It is expressed by our bodies as well. When our bodies are engaged in our prayer, we pray with our whole person. Using our entire being in prayer helps us to pray with greater attentiveness. During Mass we assume different positions—standing, kneeling, sitting—and we are also invited to make a variety of gestures—genuflecting, bowing, signing ourselves with the cross, exchanging the peace of Christ, and, as an option, praying with our hands in the orans position. These postures and gestures are not merely ceremonial. When done with understanding, they can enhance our participation at Mass.
