## Catholic University

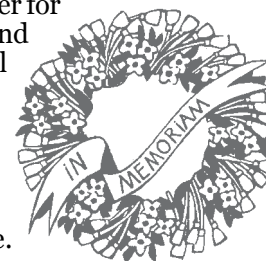

## Memorials and Feasts

**MONDAY † Most Holy Name of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** This memorial is the counterpart to the *Most Holy Name of Jesus* memorial celebrated on January 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**WEDNESDAY † Exaltation of the Holy Cross.** This feast arose as a commemoration of a unique event: the miraculous finding of the True Cross by Saint Helena. Readings for this day focus on the cross as the instrument of death that has become the source of life. The traditional image of the cross is a "tree," drawing a parallel between the tree of the Genesis account of the fall, and the "tree" on which Jesus gave his life to put an end to death forever.

**THURSDAY † Our Lady of Sorrows.** This memorial is a sister to yesterday's feast of the *Exaltation of the Holy Cross*, not unlike another pair of idea feasts, the *Sacred Heart of Jesus* and the *Immaculate Heart of Mary*. Prayers for today focus on Mary as a sharer in Christ's sufferings. Faithfully standing beside the cross of her Son, she participated in his saving mystery. Jesus' words from the cross present Mary as mother of the Church.
