Liturgical Reflection on the Revised Missal:

Are We Worthy?

The texts in the new translation of the *Roman Missal* are slightly more formal than those in the previous translation. The disparity between God and the assembly will be stressed, for the texts assume a more submissive stance before the power of the divinity. Words that affirm God’s mercy, expressions that denote the unworthiness of those speaking, and the expression “we pray” appear frequently in the newly translated prayers. The revised translation will remind us of the boldness in any address directed to God.

Planned Parenthood

Even their name is misleading ... they plan more for abortion than for parenthood (one-third of their clinic income comes from performing abortions). Now the nation’s *largest abortion operation* is the subject of a Congressional probe. A group of Pennsylvania lawmakers has called for legislative action to stop taxpayer funding of abortions: SB3 would allow the state to opt out of abortion funding under so-called *health care reform*; Senate Bill 732 would have abortion centers abide by the safety standards of ambulatory surgical facilities. A CNN poll indicates that 62% of Americans polled want abortions to be made **illegal**.
