Next week the Catholic Church in the United States will implement the newly translated **Roman Missal**, third edition. The *Missal* was promulgated in 2002; any changes in ritual occurred at that time.

The present implementation of the revised *Roman Missal* will find many of the prayers contained for both priest and people sounding very new. The revised *Missal* will reflect the focused work of many years—the scholarship of the translators, the review of our bishops, and the approval by the Holy See. The country in general, and our Diocese in particular, embrace the freshly revised book of worship for the Catholic Church in our English language. The months ahead will be a time of transition and adjustment as we gather for Mass.
