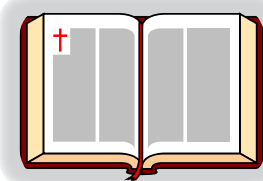

## Liturgical Reflection:

## Revised Book of Worship

Today all the dioceses of the United States, including the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown, begin implementing the third edition of the **Roman Missal**. The Mass looks the same; however, the words are newly translated, and many of the prayers have a new sound. As we gather for Catholic worship at the holy sacrifice of the Mass, we will need to be patient with ourselves as we learn new responses and new prayers. Everyone is encouraged to use liturgical aids for the new translations until we are all comfortable with the words that give our Catholic Liturgy meaning.



## This Week's Saints

WEDNESDAY † **Saint Andrew** (First Century), a fisherman by trade, is commonly referred to as the “first-called,” because he and his brother Simon were the first chosen by Jesus and given the title “apostle.” Andrew later realized who Jesus was and declared “We have found the Messiah” (John 1:41). Tradition maintains that, like Jesus, Andrew was crucified on a cross—but on an X-shaped (“saltire”) cross.

SATURDAY † **Saint Francis Xavier** (1506–1552), a native Spaniard, was one of the founding members of the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits). He was appointed by the Pope as ambassador to the East where he fought oppressive colonial practices, drew people to faith in Jesus Christ, and revitalized existing Christian groups.
